



ETFO AWARDS

DEADLINE: February 1, 2011



Anti-Bias Curriculum Development Award

This award may be offered to an active ETFO member or group of members who develop and teach units which work toward the elimination of bias.

Arts and Culture Award

The Arts and Culture Award may be presented to an active member(s) of ETFO to recognize the member's involvement in arts and cultural activities outside of their professional duties.

Curriculum Development Award

The Curriculum Development Award may be presented to an active ETFO member or members to recognize a curriculum unit or resource that they have developed.

Curriculum Development Award – Women's Program

The Curriculum Development Award may be presented to an active ETFO female member or a group of female members to recognize a curriculum unit or resource that they have developed.

Health and Safety Activist Award

This award may be presented to an active member of ETFO to recognize the member's outstanding commitment and involvement in health and safety activities.

Humanitarian Award for an ETFO Member

This award may be granted each year to an active ETFO member who has given outstanding service to education and/or the community.

Humanitarian Award for a Non-ETFO Member

This award may be granted each year to an individual or a group of individuals who do not hold ETFO membership but have given outstanding service to education and/or the community.

Innovative Projects on Behalf of Children Living in Poverty Award

This award may be granted each year to an individual, school staff, or a community group working on a project with an ETFO local on behalf of children living in poverty.

Local Leadership Award

This award may be given to an active ETFO member who has provided outstanding leadership at the local level during the previous year.

Local Website of the Year Award

This award recognizes and rewards outstanding work done by an active ETFO member(s) who has maintained an ETFO Local website during the school year.

Multi-Media Award

This award may be presented as an incentive for active ETFO members to produce innovative educational materials.

Multi-Media Award – Women's Program

This award may be presented as an incentive for active ETFO women members to produce innovative educational materials.

New Teacher Award

In an effort to identify and reward outstanding new teachers, the Elementary Teachers' Federation of Ontario may recognize one new teacher from among its members, as the New Teacher of the year.

Newsletter Editor's Award

This award recognizes and rewards outstanding work done by editors who have created at least two issues of a local ETFO newsletter during the school year. One Newsletter Editor's Award may be granted for a single sheet publication and one may be granted for a multi-sheet publication.

Occasional Teacher of the Year Award

In an effort to recognize outstanding occasional teachers within the membership, one occasional teacher may be chosen annually for this award.

Outstanding Role Model for Women Award – Women's Program

This award may be offered annually to an active ETFO female member who has been an outstanding role model for women at the local level during the previous school year.

Rainbow Visions Award

This award may be offered to an active member or group of members of the Elementary Teachers' Federation of Ontario (ETFO) or to an individual, or group of individuals, who do not hold ETFO membership, who develop materials which work toward the inclusion of lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender realities.

Social Activism on behalf of Women and Children Award – Women's Program

This award may be granted each year by ETFO to an individual female or a group of females who do not hold ETFO membership but have been outstanding social activists on behalf of women and children in Ontario. Two awards of \$2,500 and a certificate of recognition may be granted to the recipient(s).

Special Projects in Science and Technology Award – Women's Program

This award may be presented as an incentive for active ETFO women members to produce innovative educational materials related to science and technology.

Writer's Award

This award may be presented to an active ETFO member or a group of members to recognize manuscripts. One certificate of recognition for published work, one certificate of recognition for unpublished work and a letter of congratulations from the president may be granted.

Writer's Award – Women's Program

This award may be presented to an active ETFO female member or a group of female members to recognize manuscripts. One certificate of recognition for published work, one certificate of recognition for unpublished work and a letter of congratulations from the president may be granted.

The recipients shall receive a certificate of recognition and a letter of congratulations from the president.

Children's Literature Award

The Children's Literature award may be presented to an individual who is not a member of ETFO who writes children's literature. The recipient will receive a certificate as well as the rights to use a decal indicating that the Elementary Teachers' Federation of Ontario have recognized the book.

Honorary Life Membership

Honorary Life Membership in ETFO may be granted to an individual who has retired from the education profession prior to the upcoming ETFO Annual Meeting, and who has given outstanding service to the Federation at the provincial level, or as a member of the provincial ETFO Staff. The recipient(s) shall be given an ETFO pin and extended the rights and privileges of being an Honorary Life Member. The recipient(s) will be honoured at the Annual Meeting.
